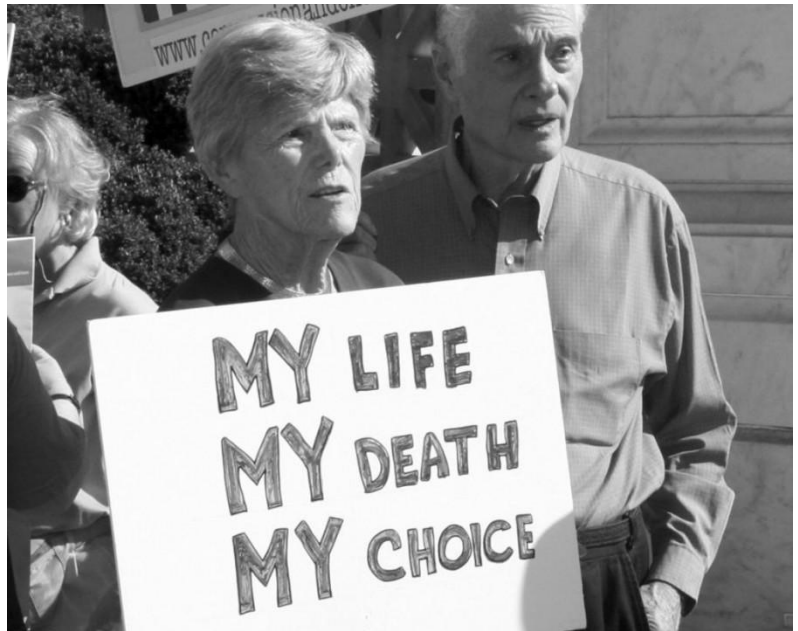

Terminally-ill adult Arizona residents do not have the end of life option of voluntarily requesting and receiving a prescription medication so they can die in a peaceful, humane manner in a place and time of their choosing.

Although medical aid in dying is allowed in nine states* and the District of Columbia, this end of life option is illegal in Arizona and our Arizona legislature has refused to even discuss proposed Death with Dignity bills.

Please join us for this important community meeting on Sunday, November 3rd to understand how you can lend your voice and volunteer your time to help make medical aid in dying a legal end of life option in Arizona. Our goal is to see a death with dignity law passed in Arizona as early as 2021.

Directions to Phoenix Indian School Visitor Center at Steele Indian School Park
